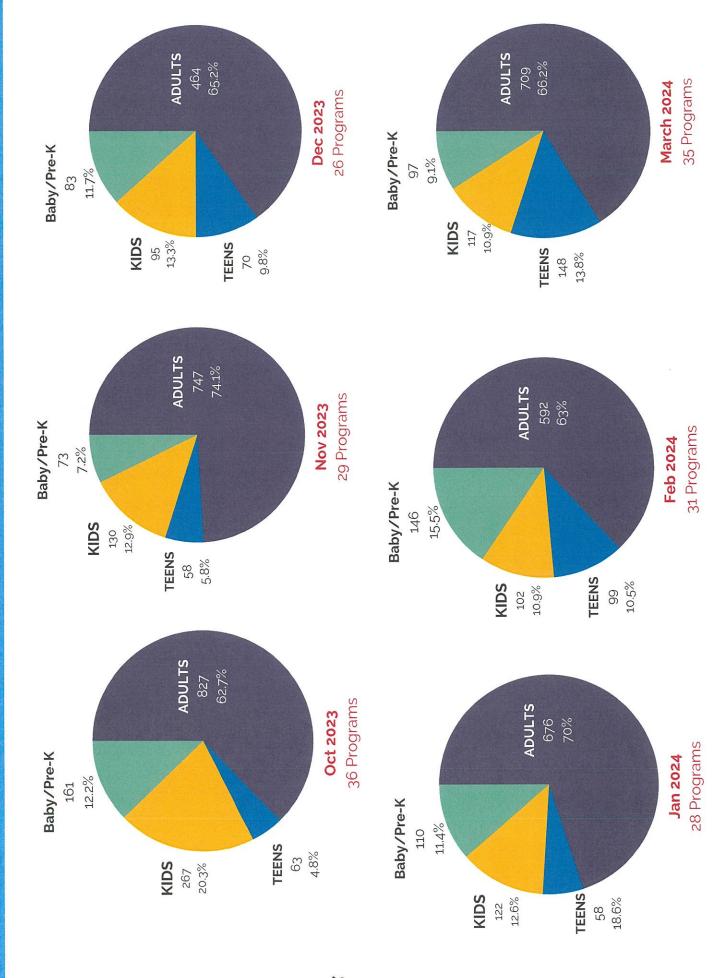

Q1 How often do you visit the library?

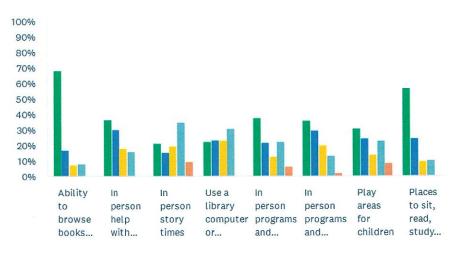

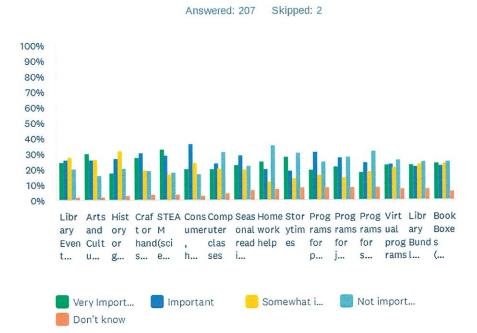

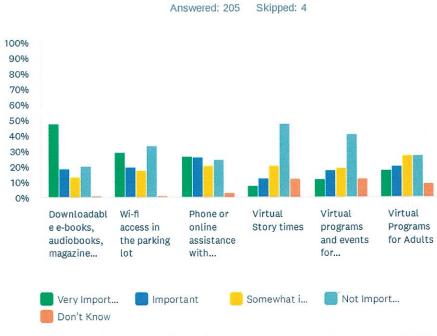

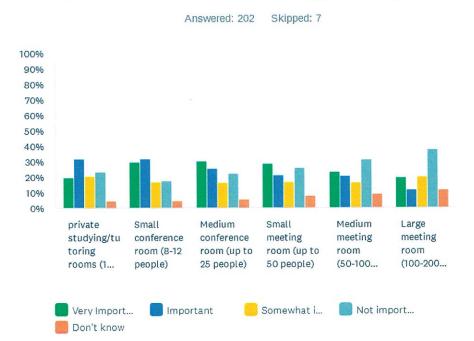

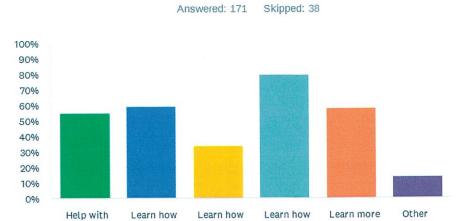

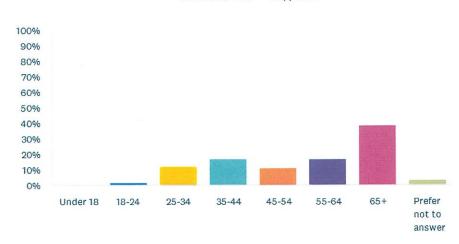

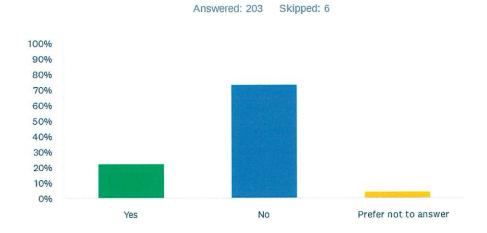
Q11 What is your age?

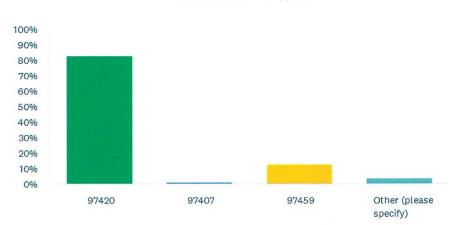
Q12 Do you have children under 18 years living in you household?
